The program provides skills training, certification, job placement assistance and job support, while preparing participants for careers in the medical technician field.

## Eligibility

- Must be a food stamp/SNAP recipient and provide verification (no TCA)
- Be able to pass both a federal and state background check
- Successfully pass a reading and math assessment
- Must provide immunization documentation (PPD, MMR, Hepatitis B, Varicella, Influenza)

## Details

- Training begins Nov. 6th; Class begins Nov. 9th
- Day and evening Classes available
- 260 hours of classroom instruction
- 120 hours in a clinical setting
- All text and instructional materials are included
- All participants are required to attend weekly case manager and job development meetings as well as quarterly workshops

- Medical Terminology
- Venipuncture
- Specimen Collection
- EKG Essentials
