

START ON SUCCESS VIRTUAL PROGRAM



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Humanim's Start on Success (SOS) program in Maryland provides high school students with disabilities the opportunity to participate in a virtual classroom setting to receive a combination of career and workplace readiness training to develop social and self-advocacy skills for independent living. The overall goal of the SOS program is to equip youth with the necessary skills to succeed in the 21st century workforce, and to obtain knowledge and experiences necessary to become competitively employed as productive members of the workforce.

Program Schedule:

- 8 week session takes place from Tuesday, July 6th to Friday, August 27th | 3:30–5:00pm
- Virtual group classes weekly on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & one-on-one with a skilled facilitator on Wednesday

Eligibility:

- Junior or Senior in high school with an interest in working
- High school transtion teacher must make referral to the Divsion of Rehabilitation Services (DORS)
- Parents must meet with a DORS counselor to verify student eligibility for SOS
- Parents and youth must complete Humanim interview and intake process prior to starting program
- Must have access to laptop/tablet or cell phone and WiFi

- Flexible Class Scheduling
- Participants will receive
 \$100 at start of program & \$100 at program completion
